Following are some important things to know about Wellington:

Website Resources – Please familiarize yourself with the site and come back often for updates. Some of the things you can find are: Permits, City Officials, City Ordinances, Council Meeting Minutes, Tax Rate information and Financial/Budget details.

Garbage/Recycling/Yard Waste – Pick up is every Tuesday. Please do not leave cans out longer than 24 hours before and after pickup. Do not mix yard waste and garbage and see the website for acceptable recyclables and large item pick up details.

Parking Rules – You may not continuously park on the street overnight between 10PM – 6AM. Please be aware of the "no parking fire lane signs" and do not park on the grass.

Police Patrol - Police patrols are provided by the City of Louisville and supplemented with additional contracted patrols.

PODs or Dumpster on your property, require a Permit Form 10 days prior to arrival.

Rental Properties – Must register annually with the City.

Newsletter – Each fall and spring, we send out a newsletter via email. Make sure you have registered your email to receive these. Paper copies available on request only.

Monthly meetings – Council Meetings are held the fourth Tuesday of each month at 7:00 PM at the Farmington Visitor Center. If you wish to speak at a meeting, please contact Mike Newton in writing at mikenewton008@gmail.com at least 48 hours prior to the meeting.

Insurance Premium Tax – Please contact your Insurance Agent to ensure they know that you reside in the City of Wellington. Often times these funds will be incorrectly diverted to Metro Louisville.

Free Tree Program – From time to time, the City will host a "Free Tree Program" to help restore our tree canopy. Stay tuned.

Yard Signage –Signage such as construction or political signs may only remain for 30 days. All political signs should be promptly taken down after elections.

Dogs – Please clean up after your dogs when walking them.
