## CITY OF WELLINGTON, KENTUCKY ORDINANCE NO 1, SERIES 2021-2022

# AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH TIME LIMITS FOR WHEN SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLABLE CONTAINERS MAY BE ON THE STREET

WHEREAS, the City wishes to maintain a clean and tidy appearance for all residents;

WHEREAS, the City wishes to facilitate orderly and convenient trash disposal for all residents:

WHEREAS, the City wishes to establish reasonable time limits when residents may place solid waste on the street for trash disposal;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF WELLINGTON:

#### Section 1. Time Limits

- 1) Solid waste, yard waste, and recyclable material containers shall be set at the curb, on the edge of the driveway, no earlier than 5:00 a.m. on Monday, or the day before the alternate day of collection during a holiday week;
- 2) All solid waste, yard waste, and recyclable containers shall be removed from the curb by 11:59 p.m. on Tuesday, or the alternate day of collection during a holiday week.

#### Section 2. Penalties

- For a first offense, a warning shall be placed on the violator's container and the address of the violator shall be recorded;
- 4) For a second offense, a notice of violation shall be placed on the violator's container, and the violator shall be fined twenty-five dollars (\$25.00);
- 5) For a third and every subsequent offense, a notice of violation shall be placed on the violator's container, and the violator shall be fined fifty dollars (\$50.00).

### Section 3.

This ordinance shall be effective upon adoption and publication or required by law.
