Insurance Premium Taxes account for 25% of Wellington's annual operating budget. Please make sure the taxes you pay are being sent to "Wellington" and not to Jefferson County or any other municipality. Each of us pays an Insurance Premium Tax when we buy or renew any of these insurances: policies: Homeowners (property and casualty), Automobile, Fire and allied perils, Life, Business Insurance, and Inland marine.

Waste Management (WM)

Due to the positive feedback received from our survey, the City has extended its contract with WM for an additional 5 years. Please note that our contract does not provide for rolling recycle carts, however you may purchase one if you so choose and WM will collect it. These may be purchased from retailers such as Lowes with the price ranging from \$50-\$100. Also, please note that WM requires all mattresses and box springs to be wrapped in plastic bags (these too can be purchased from Lowes for approximately \$10).
